

PRESS STATEMENT

Abraham Nomafo will be stepping down as Chair and Board member at the end of December 2018 due to his completing 9 years of service to the Association in line with our rules. Abraham joined the Board in 2006. He stepped down and after a period re-joined the Board on 30 December 2009. During his tenure as a Board member Abraham has held many roles including Treasurer and Chair of Scrutiny and was appointed Chair to the Association in May 2014.

He has been succeeded by Robert Greene who has been a member of the Board since 2012 and has acted in the capacity of Vice Chair since 2014. Robert has over 16 years of experience in Housing Sector, has worked for several large RP's in the field of Development and is currently the Assistant Director for Programme Delivery for a large RP.

Mr Greene said "Abraham Nomafo has done a sterling job at WHA having taken the Association through major changes in its Governance after several longstanding members had stepped down. He leaves the Association in a financially strong position and well placed to take on the growth aspirations that the Board has set out in its Business Plan".
